

**Show me the Money:** open to any dues-paying club that showed a need for funding a leadership-based event. The stipulations placed on it included that a maximum of one grant per academic year could be granted to each region in the amount of \$400.00 or less. The broad-category leadership grant could be used for materials, speaker costs, transportation/registration cost for a club to send delegates to a leadership conference, anything related to enhancing the leadership abilities of our organization or for our organization to provide leadership training to others. We did state that the grant could not be used for a club to send delegates to their own "home" regional conference, but could be utilized for a club to send members to another region's conference.

The application process consisted of the club submitting a formal letter stating the need for the grant, how much money they were asking for (up to \$400.00) and the benefit Collegiate 4-H would receive if they utilized the grant. It was decided at that time that the 5 voting members of NAB would be responsible for screening the applications. The letters were submitted to

the club's respective NAB representative, who then emailed the letter to all of NAB. We would then vote by e-mail to approve/disapprove the grant request. So, email Haley Cook and ask her how to "SHOW ME THE MONEY!"

The grants are available in every region from the national office.
